This well-known product has been refreshed to offer visitors more advantages and discounts to make the most of the capital

- The card gives visitors free entry to more than 50 museums and monuments, access to a guided tour from the Discover Madrid programme, to the cable car, and to tour visits of the Bernabéu and Atlético de Madrid stadiums and the Las Ventas Bullring
- Four different types of *MadridCard* are available, depending on the number of days over which it will be used (24, 48, 72 and 120-hour passes)
- One of the main advantages of this product is the preferential access it provides to some of the capital's top museums and tourist attractions
- Cardholders can also purchase complementary vouchers which allow admission to Faunia, the Amusement Park (Parque de Atracciones) and the Zoo-Aquarium
- The card can be purchased at Madrid Shop, the Casa de la Panadería Tourist Centre shop, (Plaza Mayor, 27) at certain museums, hotels, travel agencies and tour operators as well as online (<http://www.esmadrid.com/madridcard>)
- Madrid Shop, the official shop of the City of Madrid, where this card can be purchased, has also undergone a facelift to make it more ecological and sustainable
- Prices are as follows: 32 euro for the 24-hour card, 42 euro for 48 hours, 52 euro for 72 hours and 85 euro for 120 hours. The children's card, for which there was previously one fixed price, now also varies in price depending on the number of days: 18 euro for the 24-hour card, 24 euro for 48 hours, 30 euro for 72 hours and 48 euro for 120 hours.
